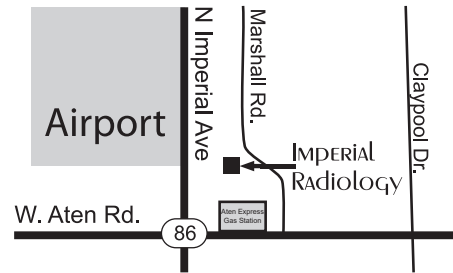

- Mammograms should be scheduled when your breast are least likely to be tender. If you are not in menopause, then schedule your mammogram the week after your menstrual period.
- **DO NOT USE** deodorant, antiperspirants, powders, lotions, creams, perfumes under your arms or on your breast before your mammogram.
- Bring any previous breast imaging reports and cd's (mammogram, breast ultrasound / MRI) to your appointment.
- You may take over the counter pain medication prior or post mammogram if needed.
- Mamogramas deben ser ajendados cuando el seno, o los senos, tengan menos probabilidad de estar sensibles. Si aun no está en menopausia, entonces ajende su cita la semana siguiente de su periodo menstrual.
- **NO UTILICE** desodorante, antitranspirantes, talcos, lociones, cremas, y/o perfumes debajo de sus brazos o en su pecho antes de su mamograma
- Lieve a su cita cualquier reporte previo de imagenes del seno, o de los senos, y discos (mamogramas, ultrasonido de seno(s)/ RM)
- Si es necesario, puede tomar medicamento para el dolor antes o despues de su mamograma.

Ultrasound Breast bilateral right left

Ultrasound Pelvic (transabdominal and transvaginal)

MRI Breast Bilateral without and followed with contrast dye MRI Pelvis without and followed with contrast dye

MRI Breast without contrast dye for Implants MRI Pelvis without contrast dye

DEXA scan (Bone Densitometry)

- Avoid calcium supplements including tums and multivitamins 24 hours prior to the exam

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
